Part 5 – Peace with God

The Good News Outline - Romans

- ⇒ Good news tells us **how** God makes us right in His sight (1:16-17).
- ⇒ Judgement is coming against ungodliness & unrighteousness (1:18).
- ⇒ God makes us right in His sight by faith in Jesus Christ (3:22, 4:5).

Amazing truths those who trust / believe in Jesus

- **We have peace with God**

*“Therefore, since we have been made right in God’s sight by faith, **we have peace with God** because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us.* Romans 5:1

- **We stand in grace with confidence to see God face to face**

*Because of our faith, Christ has brought us into this place of undeserved privilege where **we now stand**, and we **confidently and joyfully** look forward to **sharing God’s glory**.”* Romans 5:1-2

- **We have hope when we face suffering, trials**

“Not only so (that), but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope.” Romans 5:3-4

Perseverance >>> Character >>> Hope

*“Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let **perseverance** finish its work so that you may be **mature and complete**, not lacking anything.”* James 1:2

“... they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away.” Mark 4:17

*“Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, **set your hearts (Hope)** on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.”* Colossians 3:1

- **We have God’s love poured into our heart by the Holy Spirit**

“And hope does not put us to shame, because God’s love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.” Romans 5:5

- **We are free from having to earn God’s love**

“God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8

- **We are saved from God’s wrath & and now reconciled**

*“Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be **saved from God’s wrath** through him! For if, while we were God’s enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, **having been reconciled**, shall we be saved through his life! Not only is this so, but we also boast in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.”* Romans 5:9-11
