- The consequences of not doing our part 1 Cor 12:26; Eph 4:16

Discovering & Using our Spiritual Gifts

(Spiritual Gift surveys can be helpful as a first step, but we should not rely on that alone)

- Dependency on God Cultivating a right heart; making room for the Spirit Eph 2:10; John 14:26
- Dependency on others affirmation; encouragement Hebrews 10:24-25; I Thessalonians 5:11
- Development & Practice the natural process of loving and serving the body; opportunities/areas to use our spiritual gifts.

If we love others the way Jesus loves us, our eyes and our hearts will be focused on the good of the body, and that ought to motivate us to employ our gifts wherever there is a need.
