# Disciple Making – A Heritage Approach

There is a distinction between discipleship and disciple-making. Where being a disciple of Jesus/discipleship, may be an individual pursuit, disciple-making is a community and personal calling from Jesus,

<sup>18</sup> Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Therefore, **go and make disciples** of all the nations,<sup>a</sup> baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Our approach is centered on our core values, when taken as a whole form a description of a discipled person:

A discipled person is -Christ centered Lives by God's Word Spirit-empowered Lives on mission Cares deeply for the whole person Values community and belonging Lives generously Desires to be relevant

Thoughts we embody, as we pursue disciple making at Heritage:

\*spiritual formation happens in many venues and in many ways

\*it is not a one-time event, it is by and large a process, over time

- \*it involves UP-IN-OUT: UP (spiritual practices), IN (one-another's), OUT (on mission)
- \*it happens best in community, together with others, in a team approach
- \*community may be with one or two, but also in small groupings, larger gatherings, in-person and digital
- \*leadership emerges as we develop character and calling
- \*we will have a bias toward "try it"
- \*disciple making is not a straight line of progression or outcome
- \*our approach envelops every generation, from cradle to grave
- \*we want to be outcome focused-habit fueled-content flavoured
- \*we look for ways that are simple, effective, and reproducible
- \*meetings, programs, classes, initiatives, seminars and similar serve the pursuit of disciple making
- \*we do not track at the same pace or in the same way as others in our church family
- \*a personal discipleship/growth plan would be a good guide

## Our pattern will follow – What's next?

To help cater to the diversity of approaches and pace of growth, we will endeavour to provide access and develop opportunities for participation. Our approach will be guided by self-assessment and an encouraging challenge for *What's next?* for people. We hope to be able to layer our approach based on needs and resources available. Anything from individual mentoring/coaching to Sunday morning services and conferences.
