# Sermon Notes ~ Sunday, Tune 1 ~ Pastor Reece Friesen

#### Cain and Abel (Gen. 4:1-15)

We are all caught in cycles of acting/reacting. We can try to trace back to where things started. Cultures do this - stories (myths) that explain how the world got messed up, because it's obvious to everyone that it has the potential to be better than it is. Pandora's box, Osiris' Chest, Genie's lamp. We see the same thing over and over again: People misjudge their ability to handle the negative side effects of a decision they are contemplating, and everyone pays the price for that mistake afterward.

#### Genesis 4:1-15

- Origin of family
- Origin of worship offering God "first fruits"
- Origin of murder Killing another "image bearer"
  - Comparison leads to relationship issues (Jealousy, Envy, Anger)
- Origin of God's mercy marked for safety by God....
- What's missing
  - First apology (even a lame one)
  - First admission of guilt (without shifting blame)
  - First desire for reconciliation (how do I make this right)
  - First request for path forward (sacrifice for forgiveness of sins). Heb. 9:11

If we trace the origin of evil, we find the culprit and identify its presence in ourselves. Like Cain, we all think we can outsmart evil. Get the imagined benefits of sin and escape the consequences.

Why do we keep doing this?

- 1. Sin grows unpredictably.
- 2. Sin makes us blind.
- 3. Sin effects our memory of the past.

What is the answer? **Stop reacting to sin... and start reacting to God.** 

-Consider Peter trying to walk on water in Mt. 14. When does he start to sink? When he takes his eyes off of Jesus.

But because we know the Truth about the Messiah, we can choose to react to Him rather than everything else around us.
